#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. BILLY DODGE

Some words about the new rose vestments used this Sunday. I consecrated the vestments (meaning I had them blessed to be used for Mass) in front of the Blessed Sacrament School students during the Wednesday 8:00 AM Mass at BSP. I asked the students, "Why do your older siblings dress up for prom? They do not need a fancy dress or tuxedo for dancing." A student responded, "They dress up for prom because they are celebrating." Exactly! When we are celebrating important events like prom, weddings, special anniversaries, Mother's Day, we dress up to mark the significance of the occasion. How much more appropriate to have special apparel to mark the significance of the celebration of the Holy Eucharist.

I want to thank a family from Roncalli Newman who made a donation to get a set of Rose Vestments, and a newer parishioner from Blessed Sacrament who labored to design and create them. New vestments are not a "needed" item like building maintenance and employee compensation, so vestments do not make it onto the parish budget. Thus, I greatly appreciate when parishioners step forward and go above and beyond to make special projects like these rose vestments a reality.
