As we enter Holy Week, I want to highlight some important events: 1. Last Confession opportunities before Easter: On Sunday, March 24, St. Patrick's Onalaska will have a communal confession service at 7:00pm. Monday, March 25, is Confess-athon at Cathedral: Four priests will be hearing confessions from 9:00am-6:00pm. If you have not gone to confession for Lent these are great opportunities.

- 2. Tuesday, March 26, is the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral at 10:30am. Bishop consecrates the Holy Oils used for Sacraments like Confirmation, Anointing of the Sick, Ordination, Baptism, and the priests will publicly recommit their promises of ordination to the Bishop. All are welcome to attend.
- 3. Triduum Services for Blessed Sacrament and Roncalli Newman: Please consider attending Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Holy Saturday Easter Vigil liturgies. These are the holiest days of the year and your presence makes a difference. You will be impacted, but your presence will also have an impact on others. Also, we have several people entering the Catholic Church this year at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday, so come and show your support. 
