FROM THE DESK OF FR. BILLY DODGE

Over the years spiritual direction has helped me immensely in my relationship with Jesus and my priesthood. A spiritual director helps you discern how God is working in your life - especially in your prayer life. A good spiritual director should act like a mirror which helps you see more clearly. In addition to receiving spiritual direction, I have been offering spiritual direction to young men and women discerning vocations to priesthood and religious life. I recognize I need more training to be a better spiritual director. With Bishop Callahan's permission I will be participating in a three year spiritual director training program through the Institute of Priestly Formation. This will take me away from the parishes for three weeks each year. My first coursework meeting is this week, April 14-19. In October I will attend an 8 day silent retreat, which will replace my customary November retreat in Clearwater, Florida. The third meeting is another coursework session in January. All training will be done at Mundelein Seminary near Chicago. I would appreciate it if you pray for my safety while traveling, and that this spiritual direction training will benefit both myself and those I serve.

After I return Father Sam will be going on a week long spiritual retreat. With only one priest available the next two weeks we are adjusting the **daily Mass opportunities** for the two parishes for those two weeks. If you attend daily Mass please check the bulletin for the updated schedule. **The Saturday and Sunday Mass schedule remains the same.**




Then + Now Housing Access, Insecurity, and Discrimination in La Crosse
