

Please leave a voicemail, because if you do not leave a voicemail I will simply assume a telemarketer has called me. I apologize for any inconvenience, but I have to adapt in order to serve you better.

TRAINING for LITURGICAL MINISTERS

READERS/LECTORS

God speaks to the faithful through them, and the effectiveness of their proclamation of God's Word depends significantly on their conviction, preparation, and delivery. (From "Introduction to the Order of the Mass," United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, hereafter USCCB)

HOSPITALITY MINISTERS (USHERS/GREETERS)

Hospitality Ministers leave an impression on parishioners that is pivotal because it sets the tone for the celebration of Mass. Not only do you "officially" welcome someone into our parish home, you help them find a comfortable spot, offer them an opportunity to financially support our home, help them when there's an emergency and as they leave thank them for being with us today.

EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION

EMHC are scheduled at Blessed Sacrament but are not scheduled at Roncalli Newman. After training, EMHCs are commissioned by Bishop Callahan and registered with the Diocese of La Crosse. The Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC) distributes Holy Communion at Mass and to the homebound.

Through the power of the Holy Spirit, and the words of Jesus repeated by the priest, a miracle happens at every Mass. The substance of the bread and wine become the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus, even though the bread and wine still look the same. When we receive Jesus, we want to thank Him for this incredible Gift. Then we can speak with Him about anything that is on our heart. We also want to listen to what He might say to us in the quiet of our heart.

Let's pray this right now and every day this week:

Thank You for giving Your life for me on the Cross, loving me this much and allowing me to receive You into my heart in this present moment. And now that You are so close to me, please help me love You more and more, and serve You by loving the people around me. Amen.

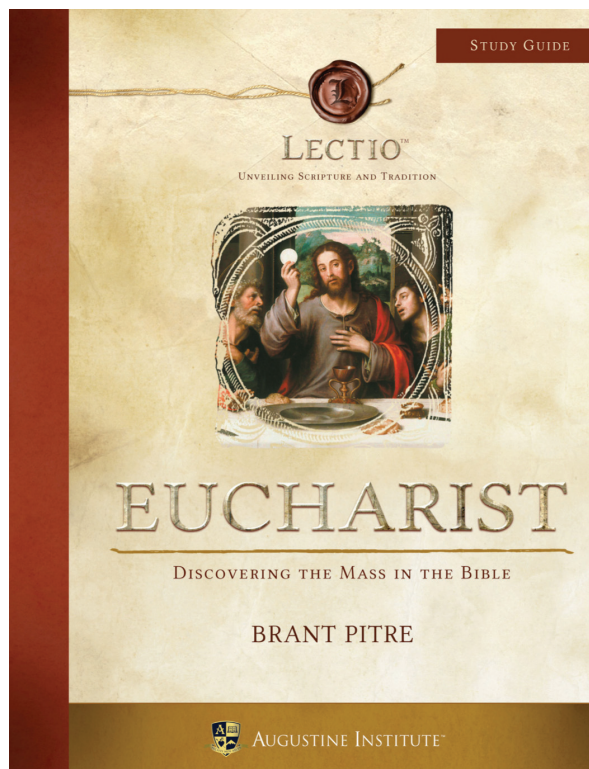
